Clermont Elementary began mandatory school uniforms starting with the 2000-01 school year. We are very pleased with the results and thank all the wonderful parents. We could not have done this without parent support. CES will continue to require uniforms for the following reasons:

1. To encourage a feeling of belonging and team spirit
2. To encourage pride in good grooming and appearance
3. To promote the message that school is the student's job and the appropriate dress is a work-related value
4. To minimize classroom distractions so all students can learn

Acceptable uniform clothing includes the following:

Tops: Knit polo style collared shirts or turtlenecks in **any solid color (ex. light blue, navy, red, white or pink)**. Shirts must be tucked in.

Bottoms: Shorts, capris or long pants (not baggy or form fitting), skirts, skorts, jumpers or culottes in **navy, black or khaki**. Belts are preferred. **No denim, jean cut pants or isolated leggings.**

Footwear: Tennis shoes or shoes with an enclosed heel are preferred. Sandals must have a heel strap. Socks may be white or match the outfit.

Fridays: Fridays will be school spirit days. Jeans and Panther T-shirts may be worn.
