East Ridge High School Student Parking Permit Contract 2018-2019

The Lake County School Board allows senior, junior, and sophomore students the privilege of parking vehicles in the student parking lot with the prior approval of the school principal and completion of a parking registration agreement. **Under no circumstances are freshman students, regardless of age, allowed the privilege of parking on campus.**

Parking permits are issued by the school and are subject to denial or revocation for violations of safety, school, county, or state regulations. Parking permits will be revoked at the direction of East Ridge High School administration when student violate school rules and regulations including, but not limited to, any one of the following reasons:

- A student is habitually tardy.
- A student uses the vehicle to skip school or leave campus without prior school authorization.
- A student takes other students off campus, picks up other students during school hours.
- A student violates school, county, or state safe driving rules and regulations.
- A student allows another student to use their parking permit.
- A student parks in another student's reserved space, teacher parking lot, or otherwise unauthorized parking location.

Parking permits are issued on a first-come, first-served basis to students with required paperwork. Parking permits/spaces will not be held due to lack of paperwork and/or funds.

The following documents are required at the time of purchase:

- Student parking permit contract signed, witnessed, and dated.
- Student parking permit application signed and dated.
- Original Florida Driver's License.
- Original Florida Automobile Insurance Card or policy.
- Current Florida Vehicle Registration form.
- Annual parking fee.

It is further understood that students parking on East Ridge High School campus do so at their own risk, neither Lake County School Board, East Ridge High School, or any school authorities or representatives are responsible for vandalism or theft.

Parking Regulations

- All students must have a valid parking permit to park on ERHS campus.
- Permits are good for the registered motor vehicle for which it was purchased and are non-transferable.
- **Permit stickers must be visible at all times. Stickers must be placed at the lower corner of the front and rear windshields on the driver's side with the information facing out.**
- All parking spaces will be individually assigned reserved spaces. There are no general parking areas.
- No student vehicles are allowed to be parked in the teacher parking areas.
- If a permit is lost, stolen, or misplaced the owner must purchase a new permit at his/her own expense.
- No student shall loiter in or around the parking areas at any time before, during, or after the school day.
- The driver of the vehicle must have proper authorization to enter or exit campus and will be held responsible for students being transported off campus.
- Students are not permitted to go to vehicles during the school day.
- Students shall not occupy vehicles during class hours, between class, and before or after school except as they arrived and leave for the school day.

Parking tickets issued for violations carry a monetary fine of \$10 per ticket. Payments are accepted in the school office before and after school.

Parking permits are \$40 for all students. Seniors can pay an additional \$10 to paint their spot. Only spots purchased in the first three rows can be painted. This price is for the entire 2018-2019 school year. No deduction of price will be made because of the time of year the pass is purchased.

The parking of a student's vehicle on campus is a privilege that is granted by the School Board. All Board parking areas and lockers are the property of the School District. School authorities have the right to inspect any student parked vehicles and/or lockers in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of students. This includes the use of drug and gunpowder sniffing K-9 dogs. Each student who parks a vehicle on a school campus or uses a school locker is presumed to know what is contained in his/her vehicle or locker and will be held accountable for any contraband, weapons, drugs, etc., which may be found in them. Each student must sign the Board's Student Parking and/or Student Locker Application and Consent to Search and Waiver of Liability form acknowledging and agreeing to the conditions as prerequisite to, and in consideration for, the issuance of a student parking, and/or a student locker that the locker is school property and may be opened by school authorities at any time without the consent and without the student's knowledge or presence. Individual student parked vehicles and/or locker searches will be conducted if school personnel have a reasonable suspicion of a violation of the law or the Code of Student Conduct. Routine locker clean-ups are not considered searches. Students must be in good standing with attendance, behavior, and grades according to the Lake County Student Progression Plan and the Code of Student Conduct and Policy Guide to receive and maintain the privilege of parking on campus.

I have read and understand the East Ridge High School parking regulations, which includes my parents' permission and signature. I agree to follow the rules and understand that violating these rules, including parking in a space other than my own, could result in a fine and/or discipline referral. Failure to pay fines or repeated violations will result in the revocation of campus parking privileges.
